Important Information Regarding the April 14, 2020 Special Election

There are three ways to vote in this election:

1. Vote at Home

Protect yourself and our Precinct Election Officials and vote at home. Simply complete and sign the enclosed postage paid Absentee Ballot Request Form (no excuse necessary) and mail it to our office, **this form must be received in our office before 5:00 PM, April 3rd, 2020.** We will send you a ballot which you can complete in the comfort of your home and mail it back to us postage free. Ballots returned by mail are counted on Election Day.

2. Vote Early In-Person

We urge you cast your ballot at home and help protect our staff but if you are unregistered or have changed your address, you may cast your ballot early in-person by coming to the County Auditor's Office in Room 103 of the Courthouse at 620 Douglas Street. Early voting will be available in our office up until Election Day, our office hours are 8:00 AM until 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday. Ballots voted early in-person are counted on Election Day.

3. Vote at a Vote Center on Election Day, Tuesday, April 14, from 7:00 AM until 9:00 PM

Once again, we urge you to vote at home. If you choose to vote on Election Day, Iowa law requires you to provide an approved form of identification or have a registered voter of your precinct who has produced approved identification attest for you. You may also register to vote on Election Day at a Vote Center. Two vote centers will be open, one at Augustana Lutheran Church located at 600 Court Street in Sioux City and at the Woodbury County Public Safety Center located at 121 Deer Run Trail in Climbing Hill.
